KEY FACTS ABOUT

Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (CULS), Czech Republic

- The first lecture was given back in 1776 at the Prague University. Later on, on the basis of Prague University in 1906, by order of Emperor Franz Joseph, a separate faculty was opened. From that moment the university was established.
- There are 16 student organizations in the CULS, including: cheerleading, leaders club and even racing cars fans club, which is also involved in their construction (CULS formula racing);
- Out of the 200 study programs, 60 are conducted in English. The university takes pride in its multicultural environment and proudly welcomes around 2,000 international students every year. For their comfort, they are given a special student guide, which is updated annually;
- The university's lecturers are professionals in their field. One of the famous professors who gives lectures in CULS is Alessandro Picolo from the University of Naples;
- High demand for graduates: 97% of CULS graduates find high-paying jobs or enter further education. Among the famous graduates of the university - the managing director of the Skoda Luboš Vlček;
- During your studies, you can take a paid internship abroad or go to study at one of the partner universities of the CULS, using one of the exchange programs.

International University of Applied Sciences

- Since 1998, IU has grown to 17 cities, 2 campuses for international students, 1,000 people (professors and staff), 80 study programs and 3,500 business partners worldwide;
- Choosing to study at IU, you get a huge variety of student activities: rugby, basketball, dancing, kickboxing, football, cooking clubs, and your own radio are always ready to fill the student's leisure time;
- IU is the most multicultural university in Germany. Students and professors in IU are from 110 countries. Here all education is carried out in English, and the German course is provided at no additional cost. There is also a special support center for foreign students;
- One of the criteria for choosing professors is the presence of at least 5 years of experience in the special-ized field. It's important for university that all theoretical knowledge of professors is based on practical skills;
- Over 70% of foreign students stay to work in Germany after graduating from the university, 14% go to travel in Europe and only 16% of students return to their home country;
- The university has a career counseling center, with a special course of assistance in finding a job: from creating a resume to an interview.

- International prestige and recognition. The unemployment rate in the Czech Republic is only 2.2%, in Germany 3.1%, making these countries ideal for future employment. Also, German and Czech diplomas are recognized not only in Europe, but also in Canada and the USA, which gives you wide mobility in choosing the country to work in. After just 3 years of studying, you will be an perspective candidate for employers, with knowledge of three foreign languages (English, German and Czech).
- The possibility of staying in the country. With a Czech diploma, you get a residence permit for another 9 months for the purpose of employment. By having a German diploma, you can get a German residence permit for 18 months.
- Help and support during the adaptation period. Starting your way in the Czech Republic, you will get professional support from coordinators who will help with all paperwork, visa issues and accommodation. The first year of study also includes a wide cultural program, registration of travel documents, SIM card and assistance in the nostrification process (recognition of a diploma of secondary education in the Czech Republic).
- Multicultural environment and language experience. By choosing the Double Degree program in the Czech Republic and Germany, you will not only be fluent in English, but also learn Czech and German. Due to friendly culture in the Czech Republic, in two years the student will get the basics of the Czech language with no spesial training. In Germany, IU offers its students the additional German course for adaptation. Upon graduation, you will be able to add 3 more languages to your resume.
- The investment with guaranteed success. By choosing the Double Degree program, you save up to 70% on costs. In just 3 years, you will receive two European bachelor's degrees at once with two leading specialties: business administration and international management. During you stay in Prague there will be a wide choice of student discounts, which will help you save a significant part of your expenses. Moreover, the student visa provides the opportunity for official part-time work up to 20 hours a week.
- Travel and internship opportunities. The student visa will open endless opportunities for you to travel through Schengen area, as well as internships in partner companies of universities.
- Entry requirements for the program: completed secondary education (high school certificate). Certificate of English Proficiency: IELTS 6.0 or Cambridge Proficiency / Advanced Grade C.
